The first of these is the 20th Annual City of Kingston Massed Bands Concert. This year's concert will be on July 26th at the Kingston City Hall, commencing at 2:00PM. We hope to see all of our audience and supporters at the concert as it will be the last performance of the Massed Bands in its current format. 2016 will be the dawning of a new era for the massed bands concert, so watch this space for further updates as things develop.

Following the Massed Bands performance we will continue with our involvement in the Victorian Bands' League's State Band Championships in Ballarat in August. Again for 2015 both the Concert Band and the Training Band will be competing in their respective grades and I know that both ensembles will do the organisation proud. Unfortunately we can't yet give definite date and time (although we do know that it's the weekend of August 15 and 16) as the program for the weekend is not completed until all entries are received. We should have a definite date in the next week or so, which will be posted on the events page on our website.

Already we have commenced rehearsing music for our 2nd annual September concert after the change to the new month last year. Our theme is *A Kaleidoscope of Sound*, and as usual the repertoire is wide and varied with a nice mix of some old favourites and some exciting new music. So keep September 20th free and join us once again at Kingston City Hall from 2:30PM as we share just another small selection from the band's ever-expanding music library.

And finally (well, for today at least), our annual Zoo performance will be on November 8th from noon. This year we have invited both our Training Band and our friends from Parkdale Secondary College to join us for the performance so once again it should be a fantastic day.

In amongst all of this there are a few other projects potentially in the pipeline and we'll release further details as they are finalised, but all in all a pretty busy second half of 2015 to look forward to.
