Darryn has performed with various instrumental and vocal ensembles around Melbourne, is Musical Director of the Glen Waverley Uniting Church Orchestra and is a member of The Australian Band and Orchestra Directors' Association.

Joining SACB soon after, Jeremy has enjoyed competition success winning two VBL State Oboe Championship prizes.
